Important Announcement about the VoVi Convention " Courage and Practice" in 2001

Dear VoVi Friends,

During the VoVi Millennium celebration on Sunday November 5, 2000, Master Tam has stated that there will be a VoVi spiritual concert (Thien-Ca) with the theme "Courage and Practice" in 2001.

Since Master Tam would like that the VoVi spiritual concert, VoVi convention, and his birthday celebration take place during the same time period, we have worked intensively with the Disney Cruise Line to move the Convention dates as follows:

Departure date: Disney Magic ship leaving Port Canaveral on Saturday, 27 October, 2001.

Returning to Port Canaveral in the morning of Saturday, 3 November, 2001.

In case you would like to attend the VoVi spiritual concert, it will take place in the evening of Saturday, 3 November, 2001, in Orlando, and details will be announced later by the organization committee responsible for the spiritual concert. Hotel prices for extended stay before the convention and for the night of the spiritual concert will also be announced later.

In the contract signed for December, the cruise line has miscalculated their prices, and therefore, we had very good prices for the cabins of Category 9. After moving the dates to November, these prices are no longer valid, and prices for the Category 9 (Oceanview) will have to increase by 30 USD per person. Please see the attached registration form for more information.

In case you have registered for Category 9 during Master Tam's birthday celebration in Philadelphia, and wish to change categories due to the price increase, please contact our organization committee as soon as possible for adjustment.

We hope that you will have the opportunity to attend the VoVi convention next year, and remind you that the first deposit should be made before 31 December 2000. After 31 December 2000, there will be a late registration fee of 50 USD on the total price for each person, and rooms will be assigned based on availability.

Questions and answers about VoVi Convention "Courage and Practice" in 2001:

Important papers

Canadian or US Citizens need to have a valid passport. Children accompanying their parents must have their names listed in their parents' passports.

US Residents (Permanent residens with a green card) should bring their green card and a valid passport (Re-entry permit).

European citizens who do not need a visa for the United States should have a valid passport.

Citizens of Vietnamese nationality (who are not permanent residents of the United states) should have a valid passport and a visa for the United States (Please ask for a <u>multiple entry</u> visa, because the ship will leave the US territory during the cruise).

Citizens of Australia should have a valid passport and a visa for the United States (Multiple entry visa).

A valid passport should be valid for at least 6 months starting from the date of ship departure (i.e., the passport should not expire before 1 May, 2002).

Cabin of 4 people

A cabin of 4 people has one Queen bed (for 2 people) or two Twin beds adjacent to each other, one sofa bed (for the third person) and a bunk bed pulled down from the ceiling (for the fourth person).

Registration Fees (incl. 7 night-cruise, VoVi Congress and Birthday celebration of Master Tam, Port Taxes, transportation from hotel or airport to Port Canaveral). Not included: 75 USD gratuities that each person (adult or child) has to pay on last day of cruise to the cruise staff.

You can choose among 3 categories as follows:

- Category 11: 184 sq feet cabin. One bath. Maximum occ.: 4 people.
- Category 10: 214 sq. ft. cabin. Split bath, privacy divider, maximum occ.: 4 people.
- Category 9: 214 sq. ft. cabin. Split bath, privacy divider, ocean view, maximum occ.: 4 people

Note: We only have a limited number of Category 11 cabins. Priority will be given to those who register early. If your selection for Cat. 11 is no longer available, you will be reassigned to Cat. 10 or Cat 9 depending on availability and will have to pay the price difference. Late Registration Fees after Dec. 31, 2000: Please add 50 USD to total price for each person.

Registration Fees for Adults: The 3-term deposit plan is provided for your convenience. Registration is only valid when all fees are paid. Fees cannot be refunded in case of cancellation. All registrations must be done through the Organization Committee. We cannot accept registrations for the Disney Cruise done through outside travel agencies.
