Important Notes about the VoVi Congress "Courage and Practice" from 27 October, 20001 to 3 November, 2001

Currently, we have filled up almost all of the Catetory 9's and Cattegory 11's cabins. If you register after 17 December 2000, please understand in case we need to place you into Category 10's cabins, if your choice of cabin is no longer available.

Important papers for embarcation at Port Canaveral:

- (1) Vo-Vi friends with a Canadian or US Citizenship need to have a passport valid for 6 months at least since the date of embarcation, i.e., valid until May, 2002, at the minimum.
- (2) Vo-Vi friends with the following nationalities: France, Germany, Australia, Belgium, Denmark, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Monaco, Norway, Singapore, Switzerland, United Kingdom, can visit the United States without a visa in case you stay less than 90 days in the US and you will be able to visit the islands during the cruise without a visa.

Please remember that you will need to present the following papers at embarcation time:

- A passport valid until May 2002 at the minimum.
- Your roundtrip airline ticket (roundtrip air back to your country of residence)
- The **I-94W** form that the Immigration officer gives to you upon entry into the US.
- (3) Vo-Vi friends with a green card and a permanent resident status in the United States need to bring their Green Card and Re-entry permit, valid until May 2002 at the minimum. Please remember to apply for your Re-entry permit in a timely manner so that you don't jeopardize your participation at the VoVi Congress.
- (4) Vo-Vi friends who reside outside the United States and hold a Vietnamese passport must contact the local American Consulate or American Embassy to apply for a Multiple Entry visa into the US. You also need to inquire at the local Consulate whether you will need a visa to enter a third country, which is the US VIRGIN ISLANDS (St Thomas/St Marteen) and THE BAHAMAS (Disney Island). Departure point is Port Canaveral/Orlando, and Destination is St Thomas, St Marteen and the Bahamas.

Please remember that you are responsible for getting the necessary papers for embarcation, and the Organization Committee will not be able to prevent the due departure of the ship on 27 October 2001.
