Important Announcements for VoVi Convention and Spiritual Concert "Courage and Practice"

Dear Friends,

Thanks to your strong support, we were able to negotiate with Disney Cruise Line for an extension of the registration as follows:

- (1) We have reserved an additional number of cabins for all three categories: 11, 10 and 9 (oceanview), and we can hold these cabins until 1 April 2001 without penalty.
- (2) Therefore, you can continue to select among these three categories, and if you register before 1 April 2001, we will be able to waive the penalty of 50 USD for late registration. Please register early and pay 600 USD per person for your first deposit (see registration form for details) before 1 April 2001.
- (3) Because of the size of the VoVi group, the Cruise Line has requested that we collect the 75 USD tip payment in advance. Therefore, this amount is now included with the last payment (to be made before 15 July 2001).
- (4) We have selected the Renaissance Marriott Hotel near Orlando Airport for your stay before and after the cruise. If you wish to stay additional nights (beyond the 4-night time period), please contact our Organization Committee as soon as possible for arrangement.
- (5) Since all practitioners must leave for Port Canaveral on Saturday morning, 27 October 2001, our Organization Committee will only provide transportation from the Orlando airport to the hotel on Thursday, 25 October, and Friday, 26 October. Please plan to arrive at least one day early (Fri, 26 October). The Organization Committee is not responsible in case of delays and late arrivals.
- (6) Spiritual Concert "Courage and Practice": During the Chinese New Year, Master Tam has visited Orlando and selected the Hard Rock Drive theater at the Universal Studio for the performance of the Spiritual Concert "Courage and Practice" in the evening of Saturday, 3 November 2001. We hope for your strong support so that we will be able to contribute our share in the mission of introducing the spiritual teachings of Master Tam into social life through musical performances.
