1) Q: In this month, many Vo-Vi practitioners plan to wish you a long and happy life. What do you think?

A: Because of love, people wish me a long and happy life, but whether they wish me a long or short life, I always appreciate it. Nothing is more valuable than this present life, when we feel the human love which brings us warmth and common joy.

2) Q: Why are there many people who love you?

A: I always love and respect everyone. Eventually, I am also able to harvest a little love in my life. There is a saying in this world: Whatever you plant is whatever you will reap. A spiritual adept turns toward benevolence, so he will harvest the fruits of benevolence offered by all people. The path of love and spiritual virtue is always full, abundant, and beautiful. 3) Q: What responsibility does one have as the head of a household?

A: A father or mother who wants to fully perform their responsibility as the head of family must understand that they should first be responsible for rectifying and improving themselves. Only then will they be able to carry their responsibility as head of family in a complete manner.

4) Q: What should one do in order to rectify and improve oneself?

A: First, one must understand who is the master of this body. The soul, which represents the principle of eternity and is directing the body in all its movements, possesses a consciousness. This consciousness is regulating everything in accordance with the existing bodily structure, and its microcosm reflects the larger universe. This responsibility is much heavier than being the head of a family. The soul is the Master of the body, and it must practice spiritual perfection in a serious and orderly manner. It must control everything clearly and in an orderly manner, at each stage within the existing infrastructure. Then, one can resolve life matters easily. When one knows oneself and the others, one will open up one's consciousness of harmony. Ordinary people turn outward, and they do not understand themselves. They refuse to use an esoteric method to develop their inner soul. They keep turning toward external circumstances, and they feel weaker everyday. They would fall prey to diseases unknowingly. Even if they have a high social position and plenty of money, these social positions and monies are only fleeting and not genuine. As they keep running after the external world, they will not obtain any results for their souls during their whole lifetime. They will lose their spiritual direction and condemn their souls to go through many reincarnations in the world of darkness. On the other hand, those who accept to perfect themselves spiritually and commit themselves to spiritual development will reap good results for themselves. They will attain harmony in both spiritual and social life, and they will progress clearly. They will follow the will of Heaven, and bring happiness to mankind on earth. Only those who accept to develop themselves spiritually with a righteous dharma will no longer err in this life.

With spiritual practice, we will develop ourselves spiritually, As we develop ourselves, we will enlighten our minds and help ourselves, As body and soul are unified in depth, we will all progress together, Comprehending earth and heaven, we will see our spiritual journey clearly.

5) Q: Tomorrow, you will return to your office to work. What do you think about the Vo-Vi practitioners in Montreal?

I spent many efforts to find a master for spiritual perfection in order to progress further. Today, I can see the miracles that God and Buddha have returned to me. They also educate me through the love of the VO-Vi practitioners, and encourage me to participate in all spiritual domains. I never hesitate to do beneficial work to help the soul in its progression, in accordance with the great vow I have made since the day I adopt the spiritual dharma until today.
